INTERPROFESSIONAL CRITICAL CARE SIMULATION

Students from University of Maryland School of Nursing, University of Maryland School of Pharmacy, and Salisbury University's Respiratory Therapy program at USG participated in USG's first Interprofessional Critical Care Simulation in 2011. The event highlighted the value of collaborative healthcare education and modeled a team-based approach to patient care for an audience of more than 100 students, staff and faculty, and local healthcare professionals.
